

Recommended Packaging for Electric pressure Cookers

Cookers should be packaged in their original boxes with foam inserts. Next best is to purchase an exemplar cooker of the same model and use its packaging.

Lastly, cookers should be wrapped in 3" to 4" thick small cell bubble wrap, placed in cardboard box and voids filled with crush paper.

Poly peanuts may also be used in lieu of crushed paper but these are a mess to clean up.



FIG. 1a and 1b—Could use more bubble wrap and more crushed paper.

NOTE—Do not “jam” packaging material into the box because the stainless surround can easily be crushed inward.



FIG. 2a and 2b—needs crushed paper in voids.



FIG. 3—needs a little more bubble wrap



FIG. 4—needs a lot more bubble wrap. Foam part adds no protection.
